

## **PAID BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY FOR HSTA SCHOLARS**

WV-INBRE program will provide funding for **HSTA scholars** attending the following Primarily Undergraduate Institutions: Alderson-Broaddus College, Bethany College, Bluefield State College, Shepherd University, University of Charleston, West Liberty University, and West Virginia State University to participate in biomedical science research. Three to 4 internships will be available. Funding will be provided to pay the student \$10/hour to work up to 20 hours per week for 28 weeks on the research for the 2022-2023 academic year. Projected start date of the internship is October 1, 2022 and funding will continue until April 30, 2023. End date is flexible. It could be until July 31, 2023.
