Participation is open to all students who are enrolled full-time at the Primarily Undergraduate Institutions participating in the WV-INBRE who will have not graduated by August 2012.




Evaluation Criteria:

- Academic record, particularly in science courses
- Laboratory experience
- Stated interest in biomedical research and career goals, and why would like to participate in the program
- Recommendations of two faculty members at the applicant's institution and others, if relevant

Application process:

- Completed application form
- Transcripts from all institutions of higher learning attended
- Two letters of recommendation
- Present results of the research project at the WV-INBRE Summer Research Symposium
- Presentations on topics related to research and graduate education such as: faculty research activities, career opportunities, research ethics, scientific presentations, and more
- Dates of Summer Internship are May 29th through July 30th
- Applications and supporting documents must be received on or by February 15, 2012
